Tourism: When people travel for enjoyment, interest or learning

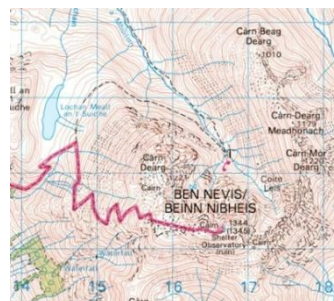
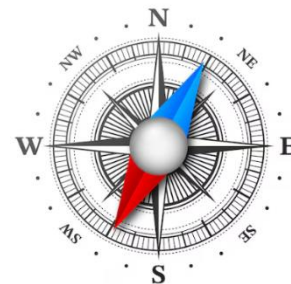
Atlas: A book filled with maps to show our world (continents, countries and their features)
