Adaptation: The ways an animal or plant has developed to suit its environment.

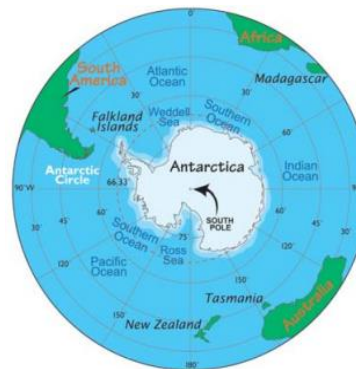
Sticky Knowledge
