Key Vocabulary

Festival: A special celebration to remember an important event for a particular religion.

Religion: A set of beliefs that a group of people share.

Faith: When you believe in a religion.

Christmas: The Christian festival celebrating Jesus' birth.

Nativity: The name given to the story of Jesus' birth.

Diwali: The Hindu and Sikh celebration of light.

Hannukah: The Jewish celebration of light.

Advent: The name for the 4 weeks before Christmas.

Sticky Knowledge

- Many faiths celebrate festivals of light during the winter months.
- Diwali is celebrated by more than one faith.
- That Christians celebrate the lead up to Christmas as well as the main festival.
- That there is more than one religion and that people in different parts of the World follow different religions.
- That the Nativity Story tells the story of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem and the birth of Jesus in a stable.
- That nativity plays are a common way for children to be involved in the festival of Christmas.
