“From Cave men to Cow Farmers”

TOPIC OVERVIEW

Pupils begin by learning about the history of Britain from the ice age onwards. They will study the Paleolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods up until the Bronze Age and understand what changed in each to begin to develop early civilisations and move from hunter gathering to establishing settlements. Pupils will study key sites such as Skara Brae and Stonehenge and learn how they are still shaping our understanding of life in the distant past

The children have settled in very well into year 3 and are embracing the challenges moving to a new key stage brings. This week, we have spent time getting to know each other and have thoroughly enjoyed our first few days together.

We have launched straight into our ‘From Cave men to Cow Farmers’ topic, and we were all very intrigued and excited when we received a letter with some interesting artefacts which we began to explore. During this term, we will explore life in Prehistoric, Stone Age and Bronze Age Britain and understand the significance of this period in history.

Maths this year will begin with consolidation of the children’s previous learning of ‘Place Value’, in Year 2 before moving onto exploring and understanding numbers up to 1,000. Following this, we will then move on to developing our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division knowledge.
