Biome: A small area with a particular climate.

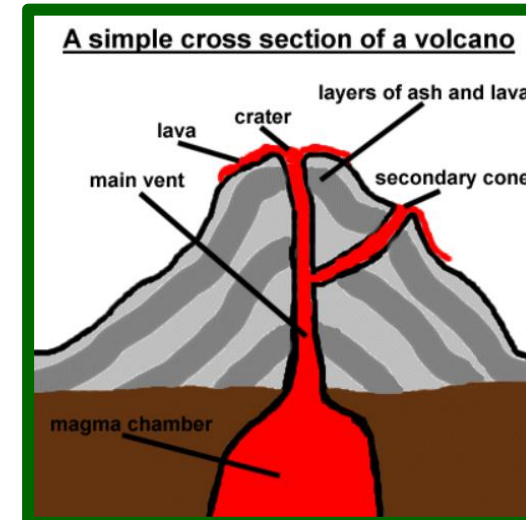
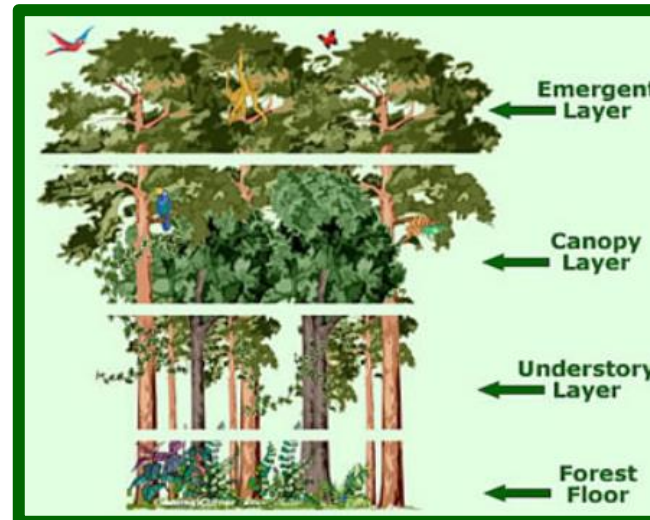
Conservation: Protecting something from harm and preventing it from being destroyed.
